What will be learning this term?

In Maths, we will be developing our knowledge of fractions.

In English, we will be writing a non-chronological report and a setting description based on our book *Street Child*.

In Science, we will be learning about light and reflection and developing our vocabulary using words such as refraction, visible spectrum, prism, transparent, translucent and opaque.

In RE lessons, we will be investigating how the gospels in the Bible are used to guide Christians in their decision making. Our big question that we will be thinking about is, 'What would Jesus do?'

In PE, we will be participating in a range of games and athletics and gymnastics with the sports coaches.

In Computing, we will be learning about web page creation and making our own web pages. We'll start by thinking about what a webpage is and what the features of good websites are to help us make good ones of our own.

In PHSE, we will be learning about economic wellbeing and people's attitudes towards money.

In History, we will be studying the Victorians and learning about their lifestyle. This includes our hook lesson with a visit to the Powell Cotton Museum at Quex.
