This term we have been exploring our responsibilities to the environment. We also took part in the Big Schools' Birdwatch. From our walks around the grounds we observed that the Green Team are doing a great job at helping to keep our school litter free. We would like to thank everyone for keeping the school tidy and recycling.

Successes

Showing responsibility: We have been listening to each other and sharing ideas on ways to keep classrooms, corridors and shared spaces neat and tidy. We have helped to sort out the lost property boxes and are making sure that paper is used and recycled correctly in our classrooms (reusing when possible, using scrap paper, recycling using the paper bins).

Participating in a survey: we took part in a bird survey to find out which birds visit our school grounds. We enjoyed working together to count the number of birds that landed around the forest area. We spotted more birds than we predicted we would see, including magpies, blackbirds, gulls and a robin. This activity was really fun. We noted that there are lots of trees/space for wildlife in our school grounds and are pleased with the work that the Green Team are doing to help take care of the grounds.
