What will be learning this term?

In Maths, we will be looking at money, rounding amounts to the nearest pound. We will also look at how to read time to the nearest minute as well as how to read and use timetables.

In English, we will begin by writing narrative poetry and then move to writing a newspaper report based on our book *Song of a River*. Through this we will learn about formal language and reported speech.

In Science, we will learn more about how to set up investigations to answer scientific questions.

In Geography, we will be learning about Rivers and their impact on the landscape around them.

In RE lessons, we will continue to learn about the Hindu faith, exploring the core beliefs as well as learning more about Hindu festivals and important figures.

In PE, we will be developing our knowledge of athletics and the skills needed.

In Computing, we will be developing our knowledge of data loggers and taking part in an enquiry.

In RHSE, we will be exploring different themes within our topic, Safety First.
