Over the course of a term, the children will research inspirational people who have made significant contributions to improving the lives of people across the world. They will learn about charities working to address injustice internationally and identify an injustice that they want to work towards a resolution for. Then children will create a plan and put it in place, recognising that they may need to reach out to other community members or people in authority for support.

Following the completion of their project, children will be awarded their certificates in recognition of their work.

This is a wonderful opportunity for our children to live our school's Christian Vision in a practical way - developing relationships and partnerships with each other and the local, national and global community.

Engaging with this award gives them the opportunity to look beyond themselves and ask 'big questions'. They will also think globally about life and develop an understanding of disadvantage, have an opportunity to take action and understand how they can challenge injustice and make a difference.
