When do I come back to school?

The first day of the new term is Tuesday 2nd September.

Where will I come into school?

You will need to come into school through the main school gates on Kings Road or by the Noah's Ark entrance. Grown-ups will be by the gates to welcome you every day. Remember to leave your cuddly toys and games with whoever drops you off for safe keeping. The gates will be open from 8.30am until 8.50am.



If you are late, you will need to go to the main school office with your adult.



What will I need to bring to school?

You will need a small bag that will fit inside your locker to carry your reading book and water bottle. If you are not having a school dinner, you will need a packed lunch. Remember to make sure that everything is named. Please keep a pair of plimsolls in your locker.



Your PE days will be a Thursday and a Tuesday. **On these days, you will need to wear your PE kit.** In Year 4, you will start swimming lessons. Your teacher will be in touch with your family to let them know when this will be.



Where will my classroom be?

Your classroom will be based in the Rosetti Building. 4A will be upstairs and 4H will be downstairs.



Where will I have play time?

You will have play time on the MUGA with the rest of your year group. There will be toys for you to play with and familiar grown-ups to look after you. You will also be able to go on the climbing frame when it isn't raining.



Where will I eat my lunch?

Everyone will be eating their lunch in the Quex Hall.

What will I learn about in Year 4?

In Year 4 we will deepen our mathematical understanding by using formal written methods for the four operations, learning to recall multiplications rapidly and developing an understanding of fractions and decimals. In English, we will be writing for a variety of genres and deepening our grammatical skills. We will learn to use a wider range of conjunctions and we will develop our understanding of adverbials. In RE, we continue to learn Understanding Christianity as well as learning about what it means to be a Hindu within Britain today. As well as embedding and deepening our prior knowledge, we will also learn skills specific to the Year 4 curriculum such as learning the recorder and taking part in swimming lessons. We have lots of interesting topics to immerse ourselves in within the wider curriculum, such as Ancient Egypt in History, the Amazon Basin in Geography, Programming within Computing and Electricity in Science.

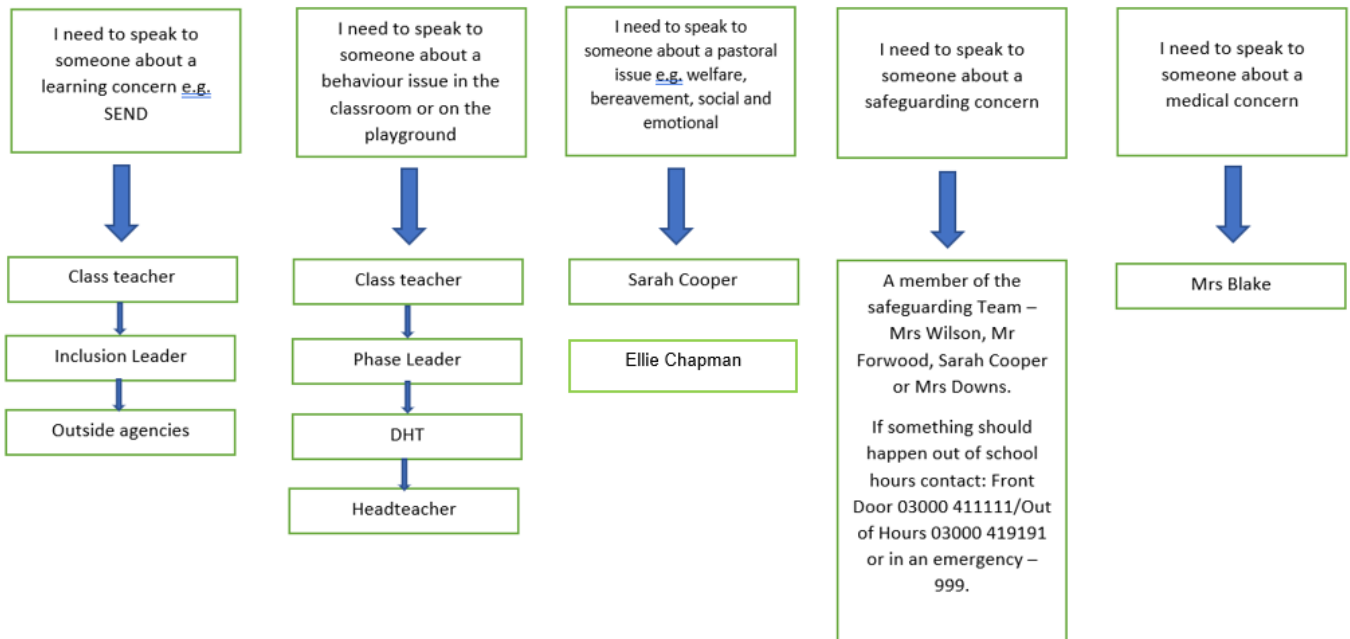
What will happen at the end of the day?

Here are some things you can do to aid your child settling back into school.
