Packed lunch



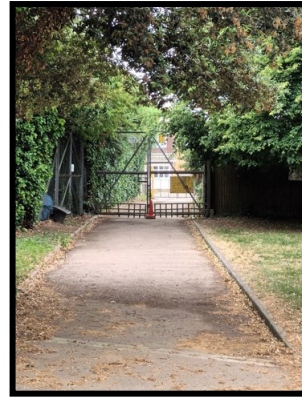
Water bottle
