## Term 5

### What will be learning this term?

In Maths, we will be looking at the relationship between fractions and decimals in more depth. We will also look at what happens when we divide 1- and 2-digit numbers by 10 and 100.

In English, we will be learning about Ancient Egyptian mythology and using this as inspiration to create our own mythological story! We will learn about a narrative arc and will use this to develop our stories throughout the term.

In Science, we will learn more about grouping living things based on their common features. We will also use and create classification charts to classify invertebrates.

In History, we will continue to learn more about the ancient Egyptians through finding out about their beliefs as well as some common pastimes.

In Art, we will explore 3D Art and work towards creating our own piece.

In RE lessons, we will be thinking about the Hindu faith, exploring the core beliefs as well as how Hindu people show their faith.

In PE, we will be developing the skills needed to take part in a range of athletic events as well as exploring the Charleston in Dance.

In Computing, we will be developing our programming skills in the program Scratch.

In RHSE, we will be exploring different themes within our topic, of Health and Well-Being. We will explore things such as looking after our mental health and first aid.
