What will be learning this term?

In Maths, we will be learning about position and direction and properties of shape.

In English, we will be writing balanced arguments, narratives and non-chronological reports, as well as consolidating our understanding of SPAG.

In Science, we will be learning about animals, including humans and looking at systems within the body.

In RE lessons, we will be investigating racism, considering what religion can teach about social issues and how conflict in society can be addressed.

In PE, we will be developing our skills in street dance.

In Computing, we will create spreadsheets and look at data collation.

In PHSE, we will be learning about personal safety, evaluating risk and knowing how to seek help when needed.
