We do have a breakfast club facility for those who need to bring their children in earlier. Please ask at the school office for the booking link if required.



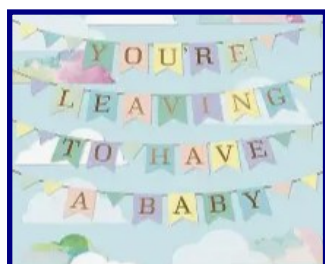

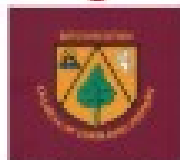

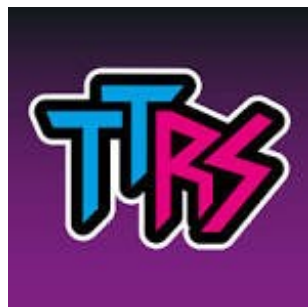
